


HSBC Business Internet Banking

Share payment status with your beneficiary

You can now share your international payment status with your beneficiary through Business Internet Banking with the following steps:

1. After a payment, **click any of the 'Share' buttons** on the Acknowledgement page
2. You will see a pre-filled email template with the payment tracker link and details, simply **send the email** to your beneficiary and they can access the payment tracker through the link even if they are not HSBC Business Internet Banking users.
